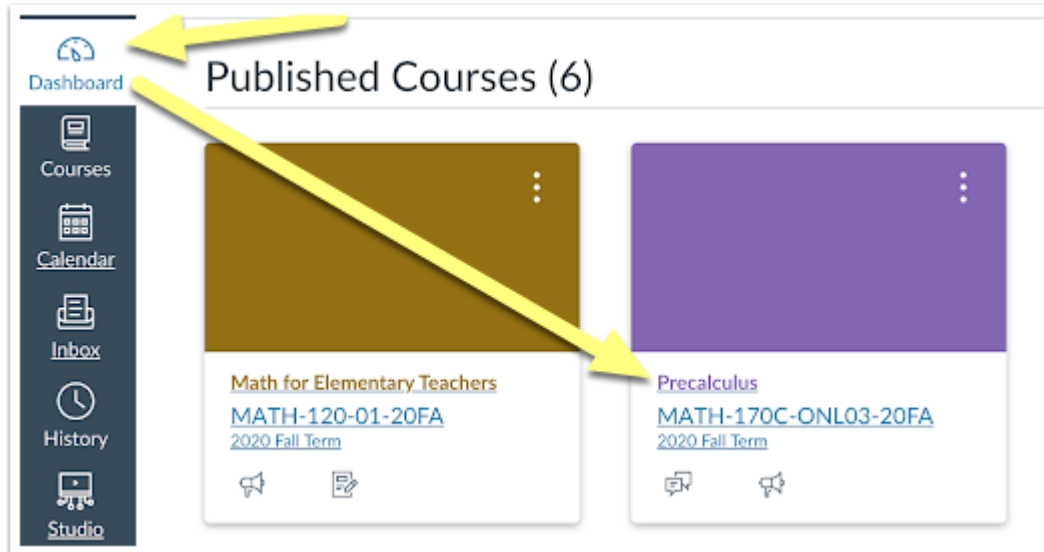
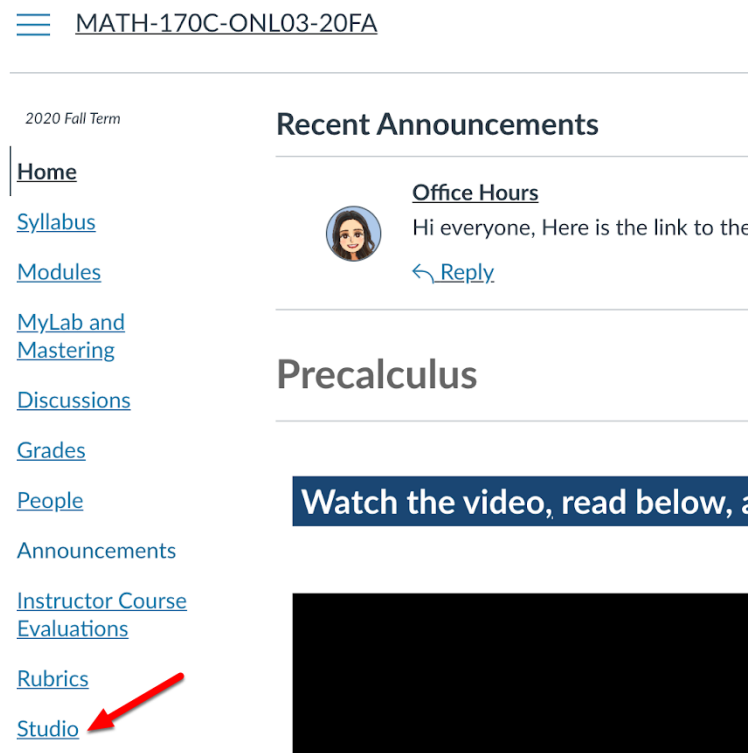


Step 3: Upload a Video into Canvas

1. Navigate to your Canvas "Dashboard" and select the course you would like to upload the video into.



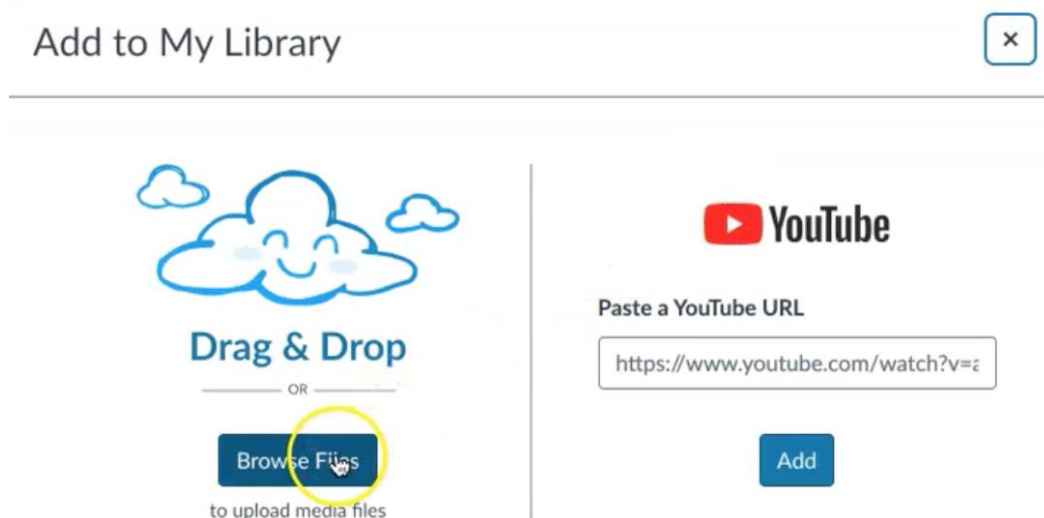
2. Select "Studio" from the menu pane.



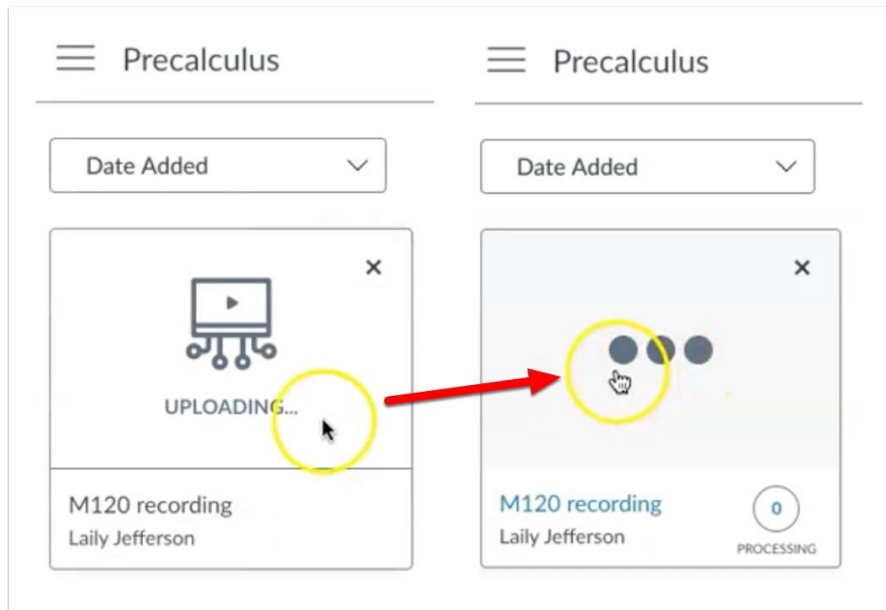
3. Find the "ADD" button on the right hand corner of your screen.



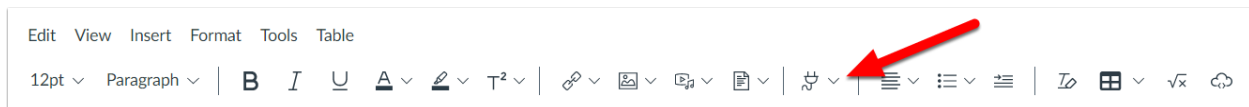
4. From the Drag & Drop screen, select "Browse Files." You can then select the video you would like to upload from your desktop. Alternatively, you can select a YouTube video by pasting the URL Link.



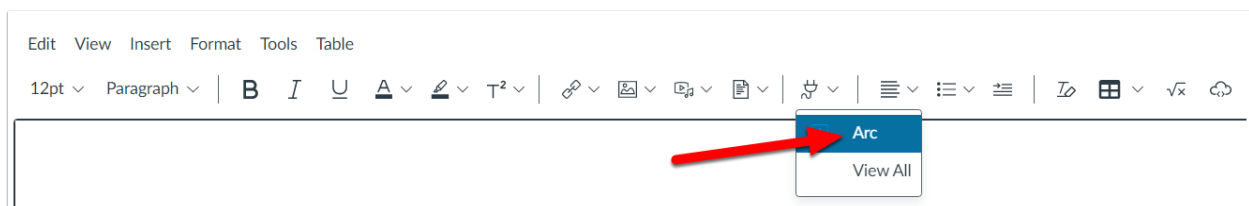
5. Your video will first “upload” and then will begin “processing.” Once your video has uploaded and processed, you can insert your video into any module in your course.



6. While in editing mode of a Canvas page or assignment, select the down arrow of the “App” icon that appears in the editing toolbar.



7. Then click on the highlighted “Arc” bar.



8. Next, select the video you would like to use and then push "Embed." Your video will upload into your page or assignment. Note: "Allow Comments" will give students the option to post comments on the video and it will show these comments in any other course that uses the video.
