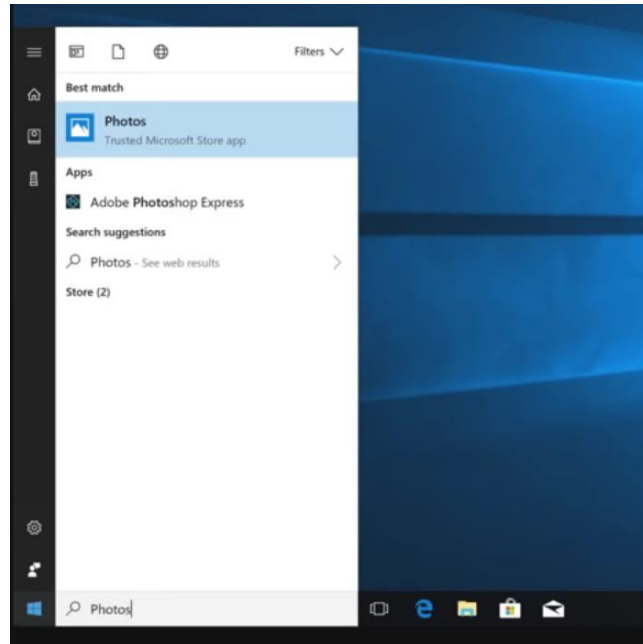
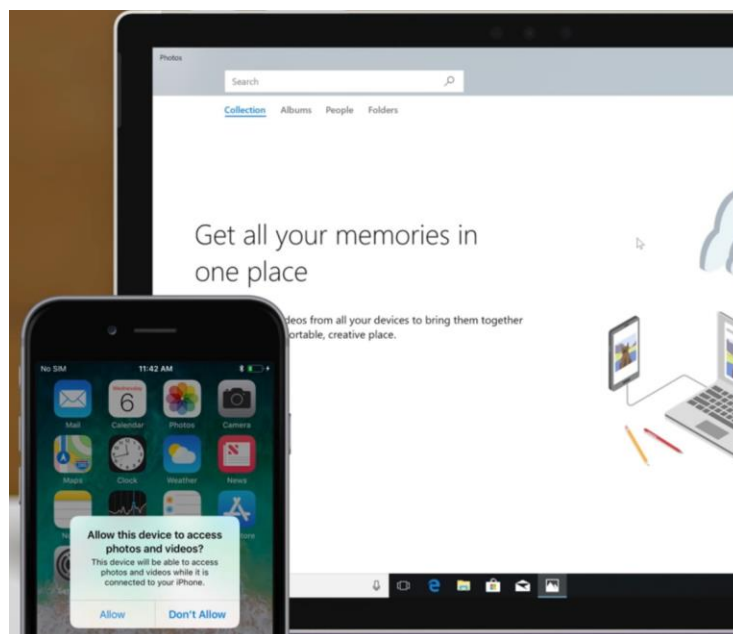


Import and Edit a Video with Microsoft Photos App

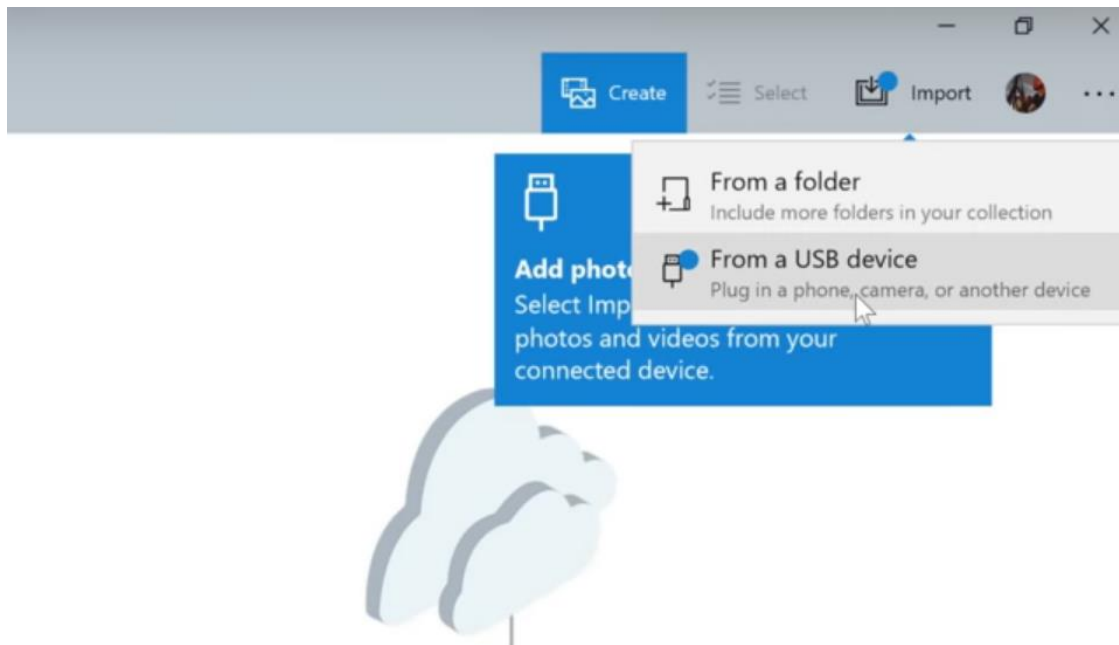
1. Begin by plugging in your flash drive or smartphone where you stored the video to your PC. Search for Photos in the Start menu to open the Photos app.



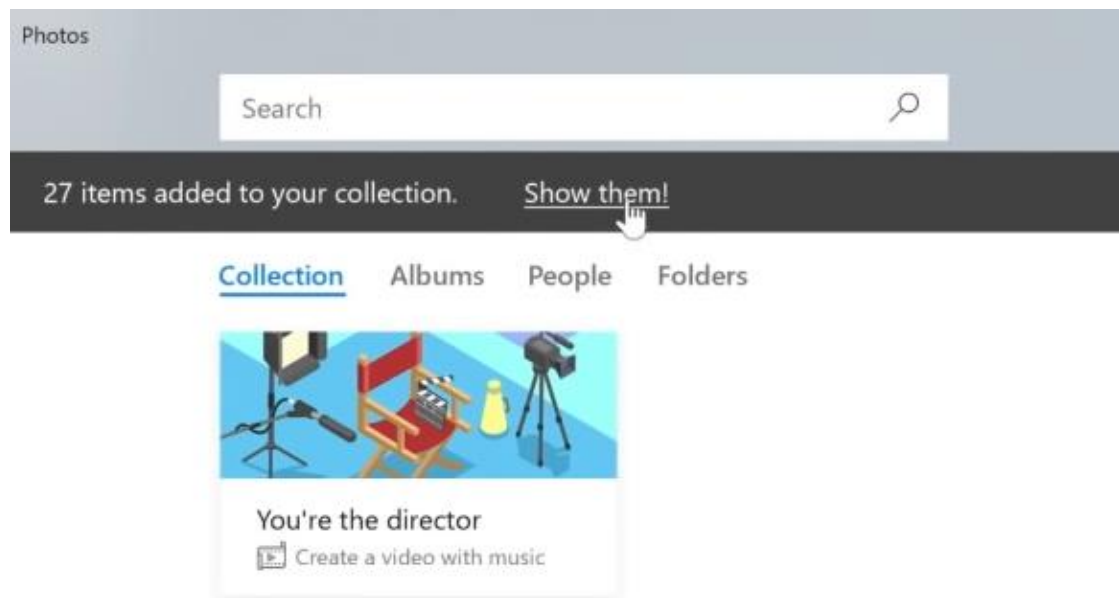
2. Then search and open the Microsoft Photos app on Windows 10 by searching for Photos in the Start menu. Look for a message on the phone's screen. It might be asking if you want to give your computer access to the photos on the device. Select "yes" or "allow."



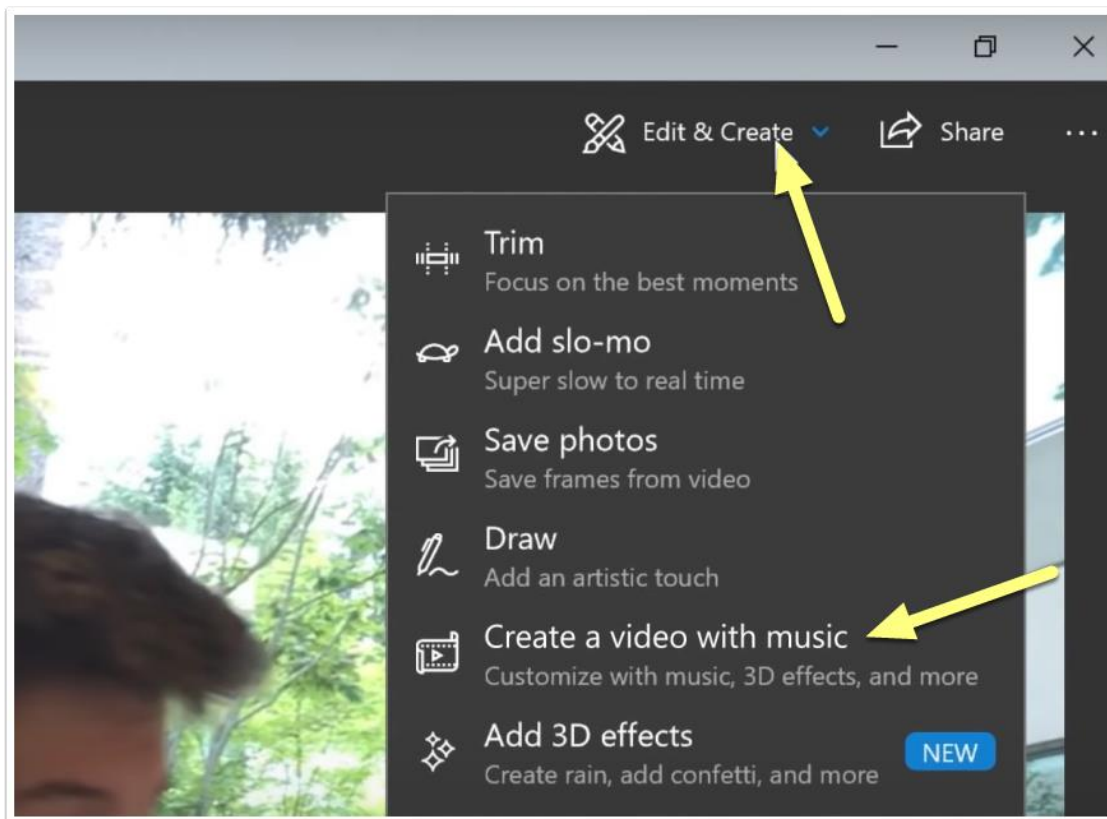
3. Select "Import," then select "From a USB device" and choose the video that you want to import.



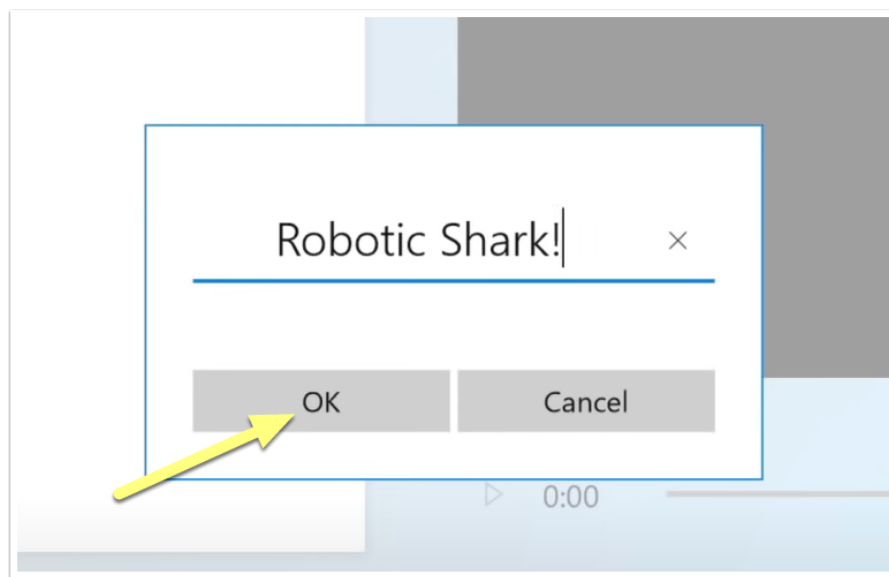
4. After the video has finished importing, select "Show them" to see what you've just imported.



5. From here, select "Edit & Create", "Create a video with music."



6. Type a name for your video, and select OK.



7. If you want to add another video, select "Add photos and videos," "From my collection." You can select from this page, or go to "Albums" to see your recent imports. Hit "Add" when you've selected everything you want.
